



**Mountain Way Common
Public Meeting #2 Summary
Tuesday March 12, 2013 7pm**

Attendees: 19 noted present and are listed on the sign-in sheet
Park Pride: Walt Ray, Becky Katz

Location: Saint James United Methodist

As participants entered, they were divided into four break out groups for the design workshop. Each group was equipped with a pack of markers, ruler, a visual resource guide, and a topographic map of Mountain Way Common including the surrounding streets.

Steering Committee members split themselves up equally among the tables to provide support and background knowledge of Mountain Way. Attendees were asked to review the visual resource guide which included the wish list and SWOC exercise from the first public meeting and inspirational photos. Each group used the guide to direct their design choices. Many circled photos and wish list items they would like to see in the park.

After reviewing the guide, each group sketched park designs on the maps provided. Becky Katz and Walt Ray circulated the room to answer questions and provide guidance. Carlos Perez, AECOM and Denise Starling, Livable Buckhead were also present to provide insight about the GA 400 trail and its relationship to Mountain Way Common. Both circulated to each group to discuss different connection options to the trail and collected attendees' feedback.

At 7:45 pm Walt Ray asked the four groups to give a short presentation of their Common design. Each group's design was hung on the wall and reviewed. It was clear that there were strong similarities among all four designs. Attached to this summary are the four design workshop drawings for review.

Everyone was reminded that the next public meeting would be **Tuesday April 16th, 2013 at 7pm**. The next meeting will include a presentation and review of two design concepts to help guide the development of the final Visioning Plan for Mountain Way Common.
